Spotlight: Mucocele Excision with Laser Technology

What is a Mucocele?

A mucocele is a small, painless swelling in the mouth caused by the blockage or rupture of a minor salivary gland duct. They are often found on the lips, cheeks, or floor of the mouth. Although benign, they can interfere with chewing, speaking, and cause discomfort if left untreated.

The Laser Excision Procedure

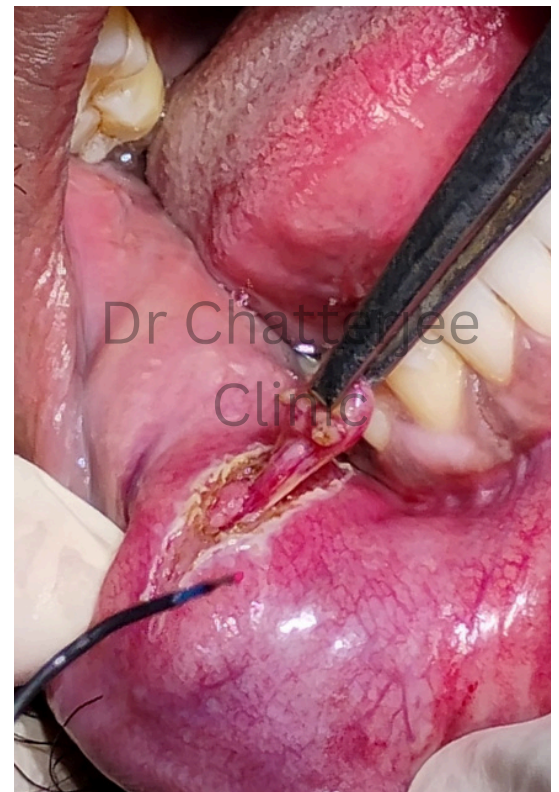
1. Examination & Diagnosis – Dentist confirms mucocele type and location.
2. Local Anesthesia – Ensures a comfortable, pain-free procedure.
3. Laser Removal – The mucocele is precisely excised with a soft-tissue diode or CO₂ laser.
4. Quick Recovery – Healing starts immediately with minimal swelling.


Most patients resume normal eating and speaking within 24 hours!
